REGIONAL OUTSTANDING BARANGAY NUTRITION SCHOLAR AWARD

The Barangay Nutrition Scholar (BNS) Program is a human resource development strategy of the Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition, which involves the recruitment, training, deployment, and supervision of volunteer workers or Barangay Nutrition Scholars. In the country, one BNS is deployed to monitor the nutritional status of children and/or link communities with nutrition and related service providers as mandated in Presidential Decree No. 1569. The NNC gives due recognition to the highest-ranking Barangay Nutrition Scholar in the region with an overall rating of at least 90% and exemplify outstanding performance.

REGIONAL OUTSTANDING NUTRITION PROGRAM COORDINATOR AWARD

District/City/Municipal Nutrition Program Coordinators assist the Nutrition Action Officers in coordinating nutrition program, they provide staff support for the BNS program and other functions to improve and provide strong implementation of nutrition programs in their area. NNC gives due recognition to the highest-ranking District/City/Municipal Nutrition Program Coordinator with an overall rating of at least 90%.

REGIONAL OUTSTANDING NUTRITION ACTION OFFICER AWARD

Provincial/City/Municipal Nutrition Action Officers initiate ways to strengthen political support, influence LCE's decision-making on nutrition and nutrition-related matters and can remind politicians of their needs and benefits. NNC gives due recognition to the highest-ranking Provincial/City/Municipal Nutrition Action Officer in the region with an overall rating of at least 90%.

GREEN BANNER SEAL OF COMPLIANCE

The Green Banner Seal of Compliance Award is the highest honor conferred to a local government unit (municipality/city/province) for its exemplary implementation and management of nutrition programs in the region. LGUs should have an overall rating of at least 85%, the average rating will not be lower than 60% per dimension. The award replaces the Green Banner for LGUs who have shown very satisfactory performance in implementing nutrition programs. This has been adjudged by the interagency Regional Nutrition Evaluation Team (RNET) in recognition of the efficient and effective implementation of the Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition.

CONSISTENT REGIONAL OUTSTANDING WINNER IN NUTRITION (CROWN)

The CROWN award is presented to a municipality, city or province that has been adjudged by the regional nutrition evaluation team as outstanding in the region in the implementation of its nutrition action plan for three consecutive years. The highest-ranking LGU in the region with a minimum score of 90% shall be conferred the CROWN award.

TANDAG CITY

With its flourishing economy, Tandag City is the provincial capital of Surigao del Sur in the Philippines. In 2023, it has 21 barangays with an estimated population of 66,000 people. The city has a historical significance dating back to the Spanish colonial period and a diverse population, including indigenous Manobo and Mamanwa communities. Its primordial income and economy rely heavily on agriculture and fisheries, and its generated revenue supports livelihood and essential services like healthcare and nutrition programs.

Concomitantly, the City Nutrition Committee, led by Honorable Mayor Roxanne C. Pimentel, is dedicated to ensuring the proper delivery of nutrition services in the city. Their goal is to make Tandaganons both nutritionally healthy and self-reliant through sustainable nutrition initiatives. These efforts have effectively combated malnutrition in the city with support from the National Government Agencies through different programs, projects, and activities.

Evidently, Tandag City has adopted a comprehensive approach to nutrition and wellness in line with the Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition (PPAN) for 2017-2022. Their dedicated efforts have produced notable results, including an impressive 80% average coverage rate for Operation Timbang Plus (OPT+) from 2018 to 2022. The city has successfully implemented a wide array of nutrition-related programs, covering areas such as acute malnutrition management, maternal and child nutrition, micronutrient supplementation, behavior change promotion, and food fortification.

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As supplemental, they focus on other vital areas like water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH), family planning, food safety, and training programs for nutrition workers. The city also produced one outstanding Barangay Nutrition Scholar in the year 2021 by the name of Ms. Robelyn Galela. Ms. Galela was awarded as the regional outstanding Barangay Nutrition Scholar.

Today, the City of Tandag deserves another prestigious award for its service to the Tandaganons and its victory in the journey towards the provision of unparalleled assistance and in the incessant combat of malnutrition to its people.
