REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL-X Resolution No. 47 (s. 2023)

ENJOINING THE REGIONAL LINE AGENCIES, LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS, ACADEME/SCHOOLS, NON-GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATIONS, AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR IN REGION X TO SUPPORT THE 2023 NUTRITION MONTH CAMPAIGN AND CONDUCT RELATED ACTIVITIES IN COORDINATION WITH THE NATIONAL NUTRITION COUNCIL-REGIONAL OFFICE X

- WHEREAS, Presidential Decree 491 or the Nutrition Act of the Philippines (1974) mandates the National Nutrition Council (NNC) to lead and coordinate the nationwide campaign for nutrition;
- WHEREAS, Nutrition Month is an annual event held every July to create greater awareness on the importance of nutrition among Filipinos;
- WHEREAS, this year's 48th Nutrition Month celebration bears the theme "Healthy diet *gawing* affordable for all;"
- **WHEREAS**, the Nutrition Month campaign aims to raise awareness on improving access to affordable healthy diets to reduce malnutrition, ensure food security, promote good health, and improve quality of life;
- WHEREAS, specifically, the campaign intends to: 1) engage consumers to support improvements in levels of diet quality towards sustainable healthy diet; 2) generate participation of stakeholders at various levels on actions towards enabling access to affordable, sustainable healthy diets; and 3) call support for the Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition 2023-2028 as the framework for action to improve nutrition security;
- WHEREAS, while July is designated as Nutrition Month, actions to achieve the objectives are expected to be sustained throughout the year and beyond;
- **WHEREAS**, the 2023 Nutrition Month campaign will provide a platform to bring to the attention of stakeholders the need for integrated actions on transforming food systems towards affordable healthy diets;

- WHEREAS, for the Nutrition Month campaign to reach as many audiences as possible, partners are encouraged to use the *MURA NA* strategies, as follows:
 - M Maximize mass media and social media to promote Nutrition Month and its advocacy.
 - U Unify stakeholders for common joint actions to increase access to affordable, safe, sustainable healthy diets through multi-sectoral partnerships at various levels.
 - R Reinforce participation of national government agencies, local government units (LGUs), schools and other learning institutions, NGOs, and the private sector.
 - A Actively engage food system actors for increased support to farmers to produce diverse food crops.
 - N Nurture good practices on transforming the food systems for healthy diets.
 - A Amplify through dialogues and other for the need to accelerate population-based policies and legislation.
- WHEREAS, the campaign is supportive of the strategies under Ensuring Food Security and Proper Nutrition, which is Chapter 3.1 of the Philippine Development Plan 2023-2028 and Chapter 6.1 of the Northern Mindanao Regional Development Plan 2023-2028;
- WHEREAS, upon request of the NNC Regional Office X, the RDC-X Social Development Committee, during its meeting on 16 June 2023, sought the RDC-X's advocacy and support in the implementation of the 2023 Nutrition Month Campaign.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, on a motion by Regional Director Ramel F. Jamen of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD-X) and seconded by Governor Peter M. Unabia of Misamis Oriental and RDC-X Infrastructure and Utilities Development Committee Chairperson, to enjoin the regional line agencies (RLAs), LGUs, academe/schools, non-government organizations, and the private sector in Region X to support the 2023 Nutrition Month Campaign;

RESOLVED FURTHER, for said stakeholders to support the NNC-X in the implementation of the 2023 Nutrition Month Campaign by undertaking the following related activities, as applicable:

- a. Issue memo circular/order to support Nutrition Month through the conduct of activities among employees and clients;
- b. Conduct activities for employees (e.g., Nutrition Month information campaign, farmer's market fair, offer special food discounts, and DTI caravans);
- Disseminate Nutrition Month references and feature various key messages of the NM campaign by hanging of tarpaulins and posting of materials on the website and other social media sites;
- d. Attend NNC-led activities, including the regional launching of Nutrition Month to be held first week of July 2023;
- e. Attend PPAN 2023-2028 public dissemination activities and learn more about it from the NNC website;
- f. Prepare investment plans and action plans aligned with the new PPAN;
- g. Disseminate information about the importance of healthy diet through radio and social media platforms; and
- h. Support the development of policies and programs to address barriers to food affordability and sustainable healthy diets;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this resolution be furnished to the RLAs, LGUs, nongovernment organizations, the academe and private sectors in Region X, officers and members of the Regional Nutrition Committee, as well as, the National Economic and Development Authority-Central Office through the Social Development Staff, and the NNC and Department of Health Central and Region X Offices for their information, guidance, and appropriate action.
