



REGIONAL NUTRITION COMMITTEE X Resolution No. 9, s. 2021

CONFIRMING THE RESULTS AND RANKING OF THE 2021 MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF LOCAL LEVEL PLAN IMPLEMENTATION (MELLPI), SEARCH FOR REGIONAL OUTSTANDING LOCAL NUTRITION FOCAL POINTS (OLNFP), AND LGU AWARDEES FOR DECREASING TREND ON STUNTING FOR CY 2018-2020

- WHEREAS, the National Nutrition Council (NNC) is mandated among others, to appraise progress of the implementation of the Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition (PPAN) at various levels;
- WHEREAS, towards this mandate, NNC annually conducts the Monitoring and Evaluation of Local Level Plan Implementation or MELLPI since 1978 which aims to assess the efficiency and effectiveness of local government units (LGUs) in managing local nutrition programs;
- WHEREAS, in conjunction with the MELLPI, the NNC also evaluates the performance of Local Nutrition Focal Points (LNFPs), namely the Provincial/City/Municipal Nutrition Action Officers (P/C/MNAOs), District/City/Municipal Nutrition Program Coordinators (D/C/MNPCs) and Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNSs), to assess the performance of frontline nutrition staff in carrying out their core functions in line with delivering nutrition services in the locality;
- WHEREAS, the MELLPI and LNFP evaluation at the regional level culminate with the recognition of LGUs and focal points with exemplary performance through the holding of the Regional Nutrition Awarding Ceremony with awards such as Green Banner Seal of Compliance, Special Citations, and Regional Outstanding LNFPs;
- WHEREAS, the Regional Nutrition Committee (RNC) X will likewise award LGUs with decreasing trend on stunting among children aged 0-59 months old for CY 2018-2020, to recognize their efforts in addressing this such of chronic malnutrition;
- WHEREAS, following the deferment of monitoring and evaluation activities in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2019 performance of LGUs and focal points were assessed by the Regional Nutrition Evaluation Team (RNET) for CY 2021, of which the team visited four (4) provinces and two (2) highly urbanized cities for MELLPI and technical assistance, and evaluated two (2) PNAOs, two (2) CNAOs, one (1) DNPC, two (2) CNPCs, and six (6) BNSs, with the results and ranking annexed;
- WHEREAS, in compliance to the MELLPI Pro Implementing Guidelines, the Bukidnon Provincial Nutrition Committee endorsed the list of cities and municipalities with corresponding MELLPI scores, while the rest of the Provinces were not able to conduct evaluation for 2019 performance due to COVID-19 restrictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the RNC X in a meeting duly assembled on 19 October 2021 to confirm the results of the 2021 MELLPI and OLNFP in Northern Mindanao, and the list of LGUs with decreasing stunting prevalence for CY 2018-2020:
