SUBJECT: UPDATED SUGGESTED RETAIL PRICE (SRPs) FOR EMERGENCY ESSENTIAL MEDICINES AND MEDICAL DEVICES DUE TO THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) HEALTH EVENT

Based on Department Memorandum No. 2020-0176 dated 02 April 2020 entitled “Interim Guidelines on the Rational Use of Personal Protective Equipment for Coronavirus Disease 2019”, below is the technical specifications of the Face Shield and its corresponding Suggested Retail Price (SRP):

ITEM	MEDICAL DEVICES	SRP (Php)
1	Face Shield (Non-medical grade face shield for community use) Specifications: Clear plastic or acetate material, provides good visibility, fog resistant, adjustable band to attach firmly around the head, fit snugly against the forehead, full face coverage (completely cover the sides and length of the face), made of robust material that can be easily cleaned and disinfected, disposable or re-usable	26.00 – 50.00

Likewise, a 10% allowable variation to the SRP may be added to account for the distribution cost for the Visayas and Mindanao areas.

Thereby, Department Memorandum No. 2020-0250 dated May 24, 2020 and all its amendments are hereby repealed by this issuance.
