A RESOLUTION TO STRENGTHEN THE TARANGNAN R.O.A.D TO FIRST 1,000 DAYS AND SCALING HEALTH AND NUTRITION PROGRAM THROUGH INTEGRATED STRATEGY, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS: The Philippines Republic Act 1148. The "Kalusugan at Nutrisyonng Mag-Nanay Act"- better known as the "FIRST 1,000 Days" Law. The Law seeks to institutionalize the convergence and scale-up the health and nutrition program from different sectors around the critical first 1,000 days of life spanning from conception to the first two(2) years of life, which to be the critical window of opportunity to promote health and development.

WHEREAS: The Law also focuses on strengthening the implementation and enforcement of the existing nutrition related laws and policies, integrated strategy on reduction of maternal and child morbidity and prevent all forms of malnutrition form such as stunting ,wasting and obesity and its life-long consequences.

WHEREAS: Article II of the 1987 Constitution emphasizes that, the state shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among their members, the state declare its determination to eliminate hunger and reduce all forms of malnutrition. The state further maintains that ensuring healthy lives, promoting well-being, ending hunger and food insecurity and achieving good nutrition for all at all ages are essential to the attainment of sustainable development goal.

WHEREAS Scaling up Health and nutrition for the first 1,000 days of life, the Local nutrition committees specially the core sector the MHO,MSWDO,DA,MPDO,NutritionDepartment,NGAs(DepEd),CSOs and Other stakeholders shall develop Municipal Nutrition Action Plan (MNAP) and allocate funds for the comprehensive and sustainable strategy for the First 1000 days of life to address health, nutrition and developmental problems affecting infants, youngchildren, adolescent females, pregnant and lactating women.

WHEREAS: Strengthening First 1,000 days R.O.A.D means, R-reaching every Pregnant women & preschoolerO-PT plus conducted properly A-adequate opportunity for employment and food intake and security Dietary supplementation to pregnant women and 6-23 mos. Old preschooler. Strengthen the implementation of laws, programs and projects, including multi sectoral integration, gender equality and promotion. Thus, to include Provision of mother-friendly practices E.O.51 "milk Code" and "Expanded Breastfeeding promotion Act 2009" R.A.





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10028. The Infant and Young Child feeding program, Early identification and management of nutritionally at risk children, pregnant women and adolescent pregnantfemales, Management of Severely Acute Malnutrition (SAM), empowerment of women on the preparation of birth and Emergencyplans and appropriate plans for Breastfeeding and rooming-in, includingcounseling. Provision of micronutrient supplementation through dietary supplementation, healthy food products, healthy life style practices, provision of lactation management

services and lactation areas, assurance women and child friendly spaces during calamities, disasters and other emergencies, Water and Sanitation Hygiene, provision and consumption of lodized and fortified foods. Organization of breastfeeding support group. Counselling and support to parents and caregivers, Maternity protection during pregnancy, social welfare support to improve access to health and nutrition services pregnant and newbornbelonging to poorest of the poor. Provision and support for the food always in the home(FAITH) project like vegetable seeds etc. Provision of routine immunizations and Management of common childhood illnesses based on WHO and DOH guidelines.Capacity building of barangay health and nutrition volunteers.

WHEREAS. Strengthen the barangays to organized and reorganized Barangays NutritionCouncil (BNC), involvement of family community support systems with the active engagement of parents and caregivers with the support from BLGu,LGU,NGAs,CSOs and other stakeholders.

WHEREAS: The Local Nutrition Council (LNC) shall be responsible for ensuring the implementation of the programs and projects providing funds thereof for nutrition and other related purposes. The nutrition specific programs and interventions that addresses the immediate determinants of maternal, fetal, infant and child nutrition and development, adequate food and nutrient intake, feeding, caregiving and parenting

practices and low burden of infections and diseases are the responsibilities of MHO and other core sectors, DA. DSWD, Nutrition Department, MPDC, MDRM, NGAs and CSOs for Nutrition sensitive and enabling mechanism, thus nutrition sensitive programs and interventions refers to address the underlying determinants for maternal, fetal, infant and child nutrition and development, such as those pertaining to food security, social protection, resources, access to health services, safe and hygienic environment and Monitoring Review and Assessment.

Separability Clause. If any part of this resolution is declared not valid, unconstitutional or unlawful, such declaration shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections or parts thereof, which shall remain or to be in full force and effect.

Repealing Clause. All previous ordinances and provisions inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and compliance to the mandatory posting and publication requirement prescribed under R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Cod of 1991.

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 005-11 Series of 2019

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ZERO OPEN DEFECATON (ZOD) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TARANGNAN, SAMAR. IMPOSING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines declares that the state shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160) accords every local government unit power and authority to promote general welfare within its territorial jurisdiction including the promotion of health and safety of its constituents;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of the Municipality of Tarangnan is vigilant as to the effects of unsanitary disposal of human wastes in health and well-being of its citizens;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of the Municipality of Tarangnan is committed to implement the Zero Open Defecation (ZOD) Policy of the Department of Health in which the municipality is one of the signatories during the Provincial Sanitation Summit;

THUS, this ordinance.

SECTION 1. Title - This ordinance shall be known as "AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE ZERO OPEN DEFECATION (ZOD), IMPOSING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF."

SECTION 2. Objective – To promote zero open defecation, to safeguard public health and wellbeing of all the constituents by allocating funds annually for sustainable sanitation programs relative hereto.

SECTION 3. Coverage – This ordinance shall be applicable to all persons, natural or juridical, resident or non-resident within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Tarangnan, Saniar.

SECTION 4. Definition of Terms - For the purpose of this ordinance, the following terms are



- Zero Open Defection (ZOD) 100% absence of open defection practice.
- Defecate to excrete/discharge fecal waste from the body or to have a bowel movement.
- Open Defecation the manner of excreting/discharging fecal waste on a place, site or location other than the toilet/comfort room or restroom and leaving it exposed to the environment.
- Public Place/s-all places that are accessible or open to the people in a community or
 places for collective use regardless of ownership which include outdoor spaces for
 gatherings but limited to playgrounds, public squares or plazas, school grounds, church
 grounds and the like.
- Minor a person under eighteen (18) years of age
- Community Service refers to the services rendered to the community for public service.

SECTION 5. Prohibited Acts – The following acts are declared unlawful, prohibited and deemed punishable by this ordinance:

- Open defecation in open places as defined in Section 4 of this ordinance.
- Throwing, leaving or depositing fecal waste in open places exposed to the environment.

SECTION 6.Fines and Penalties.Fines and Penalties shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Health and Sanitation Code of the Municipality of Tarangnan.

SECTION 7. Creation of Barangay Sanitation Control Team – The Barangay Sanitation Control Team created by the Municipal Mayor shall be composed of the Brgy. Captain as Chairman, Brgy. Midwife as Vice Chairman, Brgy. Kagawad in-charge of the Committee on Health and the Brgy. Health Worker with the following duties and responsibilities:

- Creation and implementation of barangay sanitation program;
- Assist in the enforcement of this ordinance, interrogation of the violators and imposing fines and penalties which may be deemed necessary;
- To undertake information campaign in the barangay;
- The Barangay Health Worker shall make a periodic accomplishment report for submission to the Municipal Health Office.

SECTION 8.Funding.The Local Government Unit shall allocate funds in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P100,000.00) to defray the cost of information dissemination and educational materials, briefings, meals, and transportation, and monitoring of activities. Funds shall be allocated for direct assistance to qualified benefeciaries and other expenses relative thereto.

SECTION9.Separability Clause. If any part of this Ordinance is declared not valid, unscontitutional or unlawful, such declaration shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections or parts thereof, which shall remain or to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 10.Repealing Clause.All previous ordinances and provisions inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11.Effectivity.This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and compliance to the mandatory posting and publication requirement prescribed under R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Cod of 1991.

WHEREAS, the concern on nutrition to pursue the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the Sustainable Development Goals, particularly the municipality aims to reduce by 50-100% the number of wasted and stunted children 0-6 years old) achieving food security to households and improving nutrition.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Nutrition Council (MNC) is the mechanism for planning, implementing, monitoring, evaluation, and coordinating the municipal plan of action for nutrition.

NOW THEREFORE, I, ARNEL R. TAN, Municipal Mayor of Tarangnan, Samar by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby order the constitution of the Municipal Nutrition Council.

Section 1. Composition. The Municipal Nutrition Council shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. Functions and Duties of the Municipal Nutrition Council. The MNC shall have the following duties and functions:

1. Formulate and implement local food and nutrition policies, plans and interventions for nutrition improvement.

2. Monitor and evaluate the efficiency and effectiveness of the plan for nutrition improvement.

3. Identify and mobilize local resources for nutrition interventions

4. Advocate for local support for the nutrition plan to sustain nutrition improvement

Section 3. Functions of the Municipal Nutrition Action Officer

1. Organizes and leads a planning core group within the Municipal Nutrition Council to formulate the Municipal Nutrition Plan;

2. Ensures the implementation of the nutrition plans, programs and projects which are attuned to the Municipal Development Plan (MDP) and the targets of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs);

3. Coordinates and supervises the implementation and monitoring of the nutrition program in the municipality;

4. Prepares the necessary requirements needed for the regular meetings, assessments and presentations of nutrition concerns;

5. Coordinates and supervises the convergence of direct nutrition services or other nutrition-related interventions of inter-agencies such as the Municipal Agriculture Office, Municipal Health Office, Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office, Department of Education, and others;

6. Conducts periodic field visits to barangays (which should be prioritized) to assess implementation process of their nutrition plans and provide technical assistance;

7. Supervises the Barangay Nutrition Coordinator/Scholar and acts as resource person in barangay level planning and formulation;

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8. Trains and supervises the BNC/S in the implementation of barangay nutrition program;

9. Submits semestral Work Plan based on the Municipal Nutrition Action Plan to the Chairperson of the Municipal Nutrition Council and her direct supervisor;

10. Prepares the semestral accomplishment report of the Municipal Nutrition Council and submits monthly work accomplishment to the Chalrperson/direct supervisor;

11. Keeps minutes of the meetings of the Municipal Nutrition Council and keeps the records of all nutrition-related programs, projects and activities; and

12. Undertakes other nutrition-related activities as deemed necessary by her direct supervisor

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE No. 010-11 Series of 2019

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE GREEN REVOLUTION OR CLEAN AND GREEN PROGRAM MANDATING FAMILY BACKYARD GARDENING, THE FOOD ALWAYS IN THE HOME AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF

SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It shall be the policy of the municipality to reduce incidence of hunger and malnutrition through sustainable backyard gardening at the family level. It shall also be the policy of the municipality to promote ecological well-being through the promotion and adoption of organic gardening among the constituents.

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. As used in this ordinance, the following terms shall be understood as follows:

- a) Family home-shall be synonymous with the word household. It shall refer to the house where a family resides. Multiple families living under one roof shall be required to maintain one family garden.
- b) Food Garden-shall refer to the growing of any plants that produce edible leaves, fruits or tubers actually consumed by the concerned family. May also include medicinal herbs and plants. Fruit trees maybe included but coconut trees is excluded within the context of food garden.
- c) Food Always in The Home (FAITH)-shall refer to food garden that always available in all seasons and year round.
- Back yard-shall be used in its broad and general concept which includes any vacant land in any part of the home lot.
- e) Urban gardening and beautification-shall refer to the gardening techniques in small spaces, it can be a hanging type that include the use of pots, containers, bottles, etc
- f) Sanitary Toilet-shall refer to the water-sealed toilet facility with a dedicated septic tank

SECTION 3. FAMILY CLEAN AND GREEN PROGRAM. There is hereby established a family Clean and Green Program which consists of the following:

- a) Mandatory backyard and/or urban food garden for every family
- b) Training and mentoring on current technology and techniques for sustainable backyard and/or urban gardening such as but not limited to self-watering bottle gardening, backyard plot gardening, etc.
- c) Use of organic fertilizers and pesticides
- d) Compliance with Municipal Waste Disposal Ordinance
- e) Presence of Sanitary Toilets

SECTION 5. PENALTY. Violation of this ordinance shall be penelized as follows:

First Offense	: Php	500.00
Second Offense	: Php 1	,000.00
Third Offense	: Php	1,500.00

SECTION 6. "CLEANEST AND GREENEST FAMILY" CONTEST. There is hereby established a "Cleanest and Greenest Family Contest" in the municipality which shall be based on the following criteria:

- a) Cleanliness of surroundings
- b) Food Garden Productivity
- c) Solid Waste Management
- d) Presence of Sanitary Toilet

SECTION 7. CLEAN AND GREEN EVALUATION COMMITTEE, COMPOSITION. There shall be a Clean and Green Committee which shall composed of the following:
