RESOLUTION APPROVING AWARDEES AND ISSUANCE OF COMMENDATION CERTIFICATES, PLAQUES AND GREEN BANNERS AS APPROPRIATE TO AWARDEES DURING THE 2021 REGIONAL NUTRITION AWARDING CEREMONY (RNAC)

WHEREAS, recognition of local government units (LGUs) and nutrition workers with exemplary performance in the implementation of nutrition programs can inspire and motivate more LGUs and nutrition workers to improve further or sustain high performance levels;

WHEREAS, the Regional Nutrition Committee through the conduct of the Regional Nutrition Awarding Ceremony (RNAC) commends the Local Government Units and Local Nutrition Workers with excellent performance in the nutrition program;

WHEREAS, annual RNAC awardees are identified mainly through the conduct of annual Monitoring and Evaluation on Local level Plan Implementation (MELLPI) with other additional awardees identified based on the results of the annual Operation Timbang and through the searches for best barangay implementers conducted by provinces and Baguio City;

WHEREAS, the MELLPI is a tool for technical assistance and monitoring at the same has a rating system that identifies high performing nutrition implementers and NNC has revised the MELLPI tools into the new version called MELLPI PRO;

WHEREAS, due to the COVID 19 pandemic, conduct of the MELLPI was not done in 2020 however, for 2021, the RNET plan to conduct MELLPI using the revised tool (MELLPI PRO) in provinces including Baguio City where feasible and Baguio City with some other provinces expressed intentions to conduct MELLPI PRO;

NOW THEREFORE ON MOTION DULY SECONDED, THE RNC HEREBY RESOLVES AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to approve following awardees for 2021 RNAC:

a) High performing LGUs and nutrition workers identified through the conduct of the 2021 Monitoring and Evaluation of Local Level Plan Implementation

(MELLPI PRO) in Baguio City and provinces where feasible;

 b) Best Barangay Nutrition Implementers declared by the Provincial/highly urbanized city Nutrition Evaluation Team;

- c) Twenty seven (27) LGUs with less than 10% prevalence of stunting among 0-59 months children based on the 2020 Operation Timbang Plus result;
- d) Twenty seven (27) LGUs with continuous decrease in stunting prevalence among 0-59 months children from 2018 to 2020 based on the Operation Timbang Plus results

RESOLVE FURTHER, that commendation certificates, plaques and Green Banners be given to awardees as appropriate during the 2021 RNAC;
