**RESOLUTION COMMENDING LGUS WITH LESS THAN 10 PERCENT
STUNTING PREVALENCE AMONG 0-59 MONTHS CHILDREN AND LGUs WITH
CONTINUOUS DECREASE IN STUNTING PREVALENCE AMONG
0-59 MONTHS CHILDREN IN THE LAST THREE YEARS**

WHEREAS, stunting has been an international indicator of child nutrition since it reflects long-term nutritional deprivation and often results in delayed mental development, poor school performance and reduced intellectual capacity of individuals affecting the socio-economic condition of a country;

WHEREAS, the RNC valued the efforts of the local government units in implementing programs to address stunting among 0-59 months children in the past three years by providing certificate of recognition during the annual Regional Nutrition Awarding Ceremony;

WHEREAS, continuous provision of the recognition to the LGUs in achieving and surpassing the Regional Plan of Action for Nutrition (RPAN) 2018-2022 targets can further inspire and motivate more LGUs to improve their nutrition program implementation and sustain their performance;

WHEREAS, criteria for recognition include LGUs with less than 10% prevalence of stunting among 0-59 months children in 2019 and LGUs with continuous decrease in stunting from 2017 to 2019;


WHEREAS, based on the 2019 Operation Timbang Plus result, there are 22 municipalities, 2 provinces and 1 city with below 10% stunting prevalence in 2019 and there are 27 municipalities, 3 provinces and 1 city with continuous decrease of stunting prevalence from 2017 to 2019 for recognition;

**NOW THEREFORE ON MOTION DULY SECONDED, RESOLVED, AS IT IS
HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the RNC gives commendation to LGUs having less than 10 percent stunting prevalence and LGUs that showed consistent decrease in the stunting prevalence from 2017 to 2019;


RESOLVE FURTHER, that certificates of commendation be awarded to LGUs for their performance during the 2020 Regional Nutrition Awarding Ceremony (RNAC);
