1. Food Assistance: Caloocan, Malabon, Valenzuela, Mandaluyong, Pasig, Taguig, Las Pinas, and Muntinlupa provided hot meals and or food packs to 5,398 evacuees (families, children, pregnant and lactating, elderly and PWDs).

3. Infant and Young Child Feeding: All LGUs were very vigilant in monitoring milk formula donation in evacuation centers; Muntinlupa City posted 'No Milk Donation' tarpaulin and set up breastfeeding tent in all ECs; three (3) pregnant and lactating women were counseled on breastfeeding and proper complementary feeding in Mandaluyong and Muntinlupa; two (2) lactating mothers given breastfeeding kit in Taguig.

A RESOLUTION INTEGRATING THE MUNTINLUPA NUTRITION COMMITTEE (MNC AS A SUBSTRUCTURE TO THE MUNTINLUPA DISASTER RISK REDUCTION COUNCIL TO PROVIDE GUIDELINES/POLICIES IN THE DISTRIBUTION OF HEALTHY AND NUTRITIOUS FOOD PACKS DURING STATE OF PUBLIC EMERGENCIES AND DISASTERS

WHEREAS, Article II Section 15 of the Philippine Constitution states that. "The State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them.":

WHEREAS, under the NCCGB Resolution, the Local Nutrition Committee (LNC) shall function as a local nutrition cluster that should take charge of the nutrition management in emergencies and disasters;

WHEREAS, LNC are directed to ensure that its efforts and initiatives are linked with other clusters such as psychosocial, social protection, food and non-food clusters al of which are also under the local disaster coordinating councils

EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 58 Series of 2022

PROVIDING FOR THE OBGANIZATION OF THE CITY OF MUNTINLUPA NUTRITION CLUSTER IN TIMES OF EMERGENCIES AND DISASTERS, ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, the Philippines is located along the typhoon belt in the Pacific, and is visited by an average of twenty (20) typhoons every year, five (5) of which are painfully destructive;

WHEREAS, the Philippines, being situated in the "Pacific Ring of Fire," makes it vulnerable to frequent earthquakes and volcanic eruptions. Its geographical location and physical environment also contributes to its high-susceptibility to tsunami, sea level rise, storm surges, landslides, floods, and drought;

WHEREAS, on 27 May 2010, the Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (PDRRM) Act, provided for the adoption of a "disaster risk reduction and management approach that is holistic, comprehensive, integrated, and proactive in lessening the socio-economic and environmental impacts of disasters including climate change, and promote the involvement and participation of all sectors and all stakeholders concerned, at all levels, especially the local community;"

WHEREAS, the cluster approach, introduced as part of the humanitarian reform, aims at ensuring

clear leadership, predictability and accountability in responses to humanitarian emergencies by clarifying the division of labor among organizations and better defining their roles and responsibilities within the different sectors involved in the response;

WHEREAS, the cluster approach was officially adopted by the Philippines in 2007, focuses on preparedness in normal times and responds to all emergencies when they occur;

WHEREAS, the Nutrition Cluster, under the Health Cluster, is spearheaded by the National Nutrition Council with the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) as co-lead agency, also provides technical support to Local Nutrition Committees who also serve as the Local Nutrition Clusters during emergencies;
