# RDC ExCom Resolution No. 52, s. 2009

#### LINE AGENCIES AND REGIONAL LOCAL ENIOINING ALL UNIT'S ESTABLISH BREASTFEEDING GOVERNMENT TO A ROOM/CORNER IN THE WORKPLACE IN SUPPORT TO 1.448 BREASTFEEDING CAMPAIGN

WHEREAS, breastfeeding has distinct advantages which benefit the infant and the mother including the hospital and the country that adopts its practice;

WHEREAS, in the 2008 National Demographic and Health Survey, breastfeeding rates in the country went down to 50 percent in 2008 from 53 percent in 2003 and it further showed that only 34 percent of infants below six months are being exclusively breastfed;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7600 (The Rooming-In and Breastfeeding Act of 1992) and Executive Order 51 of 1986 (The Milk Code) were passed to advocate the promotion and sustainability of the campaign against breastfeeding problems;

WHEREAS, in order to ensure that safe and adequate matition for infants is provided, there is a need for all government offices to allow their breastfeeding employees to bring their babies at the workplace;

WHEREAS, the Breastfeeding Room/Corner will promote and strengthen optimal maternal and child health nutrition to all concerned mothers in the effort to decrease the malnutrition problem as well as enhance right feeding among infants;

WHEREFORE, upon the recommendation of the RSDC through NNC Resolution No. 01, s. 2009 and the motion duly seconded;

**BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, to er.join the all regional line agencies and local government units to establish a breast reding room/corner in the workplace in support to the breastfeeding campaign;
